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## Spending Categories

Directions: We have previously learned that we should try to spend no more than $70 \%$ of our income, save no less than $20 \%$ of our income, and invest no less than $10 \%$ of our income. In this activity you are going to focus on spending your income. What eight categories can you think of that best describe areas which you should spend your income on? For example, everyone should spend a portion of their income on housing. But what percent of your income should you spend on housing? In your groups or individually, think of 8 total spending categories and which percent of your income should be spent on each category. The total of all percentages should add up to $100 \%$.
